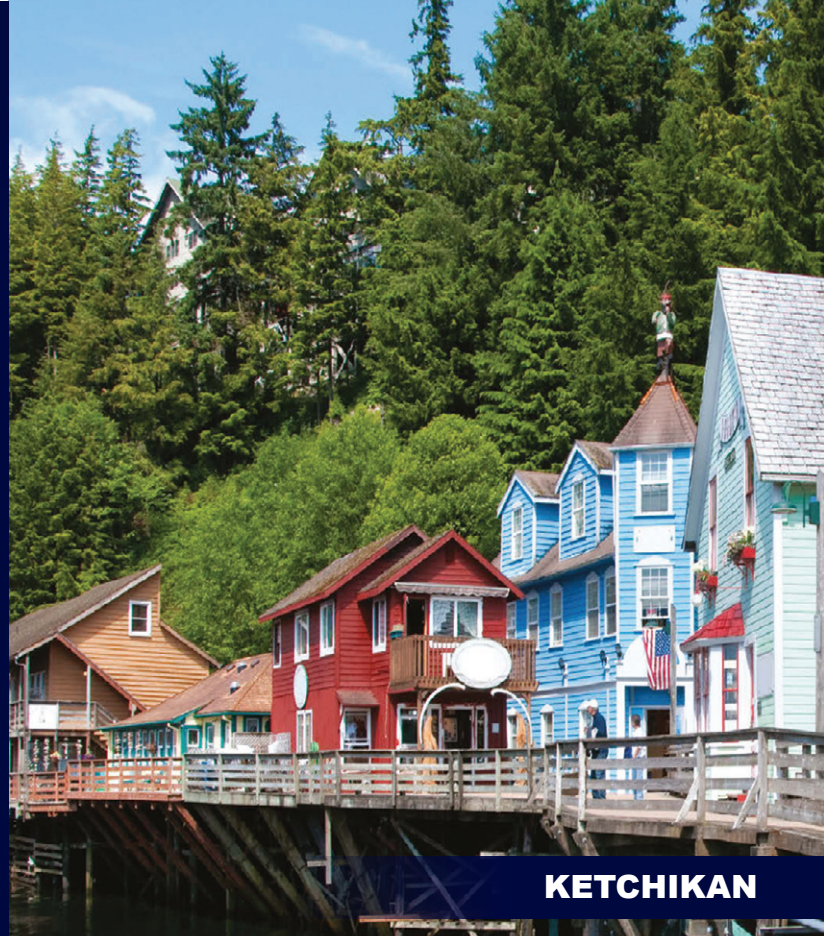
For exhilarating views, head to the top of the Space Needle.

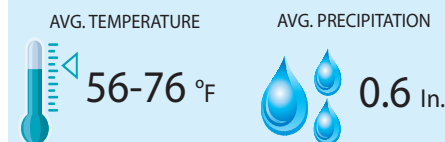
DAY 1 - FLY AWAY

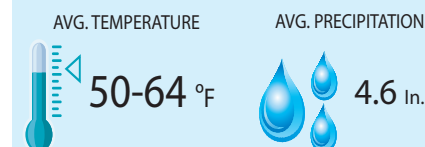
DAY 3 - FUN DAY AT SEA
